Under the Zero Emissions Government Framework, ACTPS entities have a target of 33% emissions reduction on 2020 levels. Infrastructure Canberra had an increase in emissions of 102% over the 2024-25 financial year. How much of this increase can be attributed to transfer of ownership of aquatic facilities to Infrastructure Canberra, and how much is attributable to other sources? Are you able to detail the sources of other emissions increases over 2024-25 for Infrastructure Canberra?

Andrew Barr MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

The transfer of aquatic facilities to Infrastructure Canberra (iCBR) resulted in an approximate 100 per cent increase in iCBR's reported emissions for 2024–25.

Additional growth was driven by a colder autumn and winter in 2025, which led to increased and sustained use of gas-fired space and water heating systems across iCBR properties.
