Dear Committee,

Please include my comments and concerns below in your inquiry:

- I'm having some wins with Fix My Street but many go for months without a response.
 - the process of taking photos and then submitting a Fix-My-Street job is very time consuming
 - I'm usually so focused on transporting my daughter to her daycare or commuting to work on my bicycle that it's hard to manage taking photos of the bushes and trees that need maintenance along the way. Some of them will take your head off if you are not too careful!
- The issue nearest and dearest to me is the regular upkeep of shared pathways and walking paths, primarily:
 - overgrowth of hedges, trees, bushes that push pedestrians off these paths
 - regular maintenance of these paths
 - There is a lack of specificity on how often an agency does any upkeep of a shared pathway (or even if there is a regular schedule or does it only happen when they get a Fix-my-street submission?)
- **curb cuts/ramps** on walking path corners in the older suburbs like Griffith and Deakin.
 - It's December and I'm crossing my fingers that curb cuts I requested well over a year ago on Barron St Deakin ([REDACTED]) will actually be actioned by the end of December, as I was told by MLA Carrick ([REDACTED]) and MLA Paterson.
