There was an incident occur in our after school program on Monday 28th March, that resulted in a child pulling her pants down and two other children touching her vagina. The attachments to this incident are important as it gives more context and an in depth understanding as to what was involved, and I am limited here with the amount of characters I can use to do this here.

The incident involves **P01P01** **P01P01** and **P01P01**. The service has constantly been seeking additional support and making internal CYPS reports in relation to **P01P01** and his younger brother **P01**'s struggles and severe behavioural problems, as the service does not have the appropriate therapeutic/intensive training required to support this vulnerable family.

P0P01 family have withdrawn her from the service, and will potentially seek sexual assault charges against either the service/the children involved in the incident.
