Fix My Street inquiry report released

The Standing Committee on Transport and City Services has tabled its report on the Inquiry into the effectiveness of Fix My Street.

‘Since 2021 concerted efforts have been made to improve Fix My Street, with the system being subject to a redesign project, a remediation project, and now to a continuous improvement program,’ said Leanne Castley MLA, Committee Chair. ‘These efforts have focused on user engagement via the website, the behind-the-scenes allocation of requests, and communication with the public about the responses to requests.’

‘In light of the evidence received from Fix My Street users, this inquiry has led the Committee to commence an inquiry into municipal services,’ Ms Castley continued. ‘The Committee thanks everyone who helped shape both this report and the Committee’s future work.’
