While outside with ten children, P01 was packing up the yard in preparation to have afternoon tea and go inside. She saw Child 1 and Child 2 playing in the tunnel. These two children usually play together. She called them to help pack up, and when they didn't respond, she walked over to the tunnel. As she approached, she saw that Child 1 was lying down on their back, and Child 2 was leaning over them and licked, what she initially thought was Child 1's thumb, but as she drew closer, she realised it was Child 1's erect penis. She told both children to get out of the tunnel. They said, "We're just playing". P01 told the two children to go inside to wash their hands for afternoon tea. P01 went to P01, the Responsible Person at the time to ask what to do. P01 and P01 rang P01, the Nominated Supervisor. P01 advised them to talk to the children and tell them that we don't let other people near our genitals (apart from parents, doctors and teachers if you need help), and that the game they were playing was not suitable for Kirinari. P01 advised that they write an incident report for both children and speak with the parents at pick-up. Child 2's father arrived as the three were talking on the phone, so P01 spoke to the father. The mother of Child 1 was told when she arrived to collect. The mother of Child 2 came in the following day (Wednesday) to discuss the incident a little more with P01 and P01 (RP at the time), as the father hadn't asked any questions and seemed awkward in the conversation. Both mothers were happy with how the educators dealt with the situation and the plan moving forward. On Thursday, the mother of Child 2 returned to speak with P01. She informed her that the father had decided he didn't want his child to return to the centre and that they were withdrawing him immediately. The mother reassured P01 that she was happy with how it was handled but that the father couldn't move past it.

P01, the Assistant Director/EL felt that the incident should be reported to CYPS, so she made a report. P01 is yet to hear anything from CYPS.

Steps that were taken or will be taken to prevent or minimise this type of incident in the future

Supervision review of the playground has been discussed and continues to be addressed. Educators are mindful to close off areas of the room or playground that cannot be supervised effectively in times of transition or when there are limited educators to supervise a space (e.g. When doing our indoor/outdoor program and there are 10 children inside with 1 educator and 10 outside with 1 educator, they are restricting the play space to areas that they can easily monitor).

Discussions with children about body safety, consent etc. have been put into the monthly program.
