Dr Marisa Paterson MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

Infrastructure Canberra (iCBR) has not procured feasibility studies, design options, preliminary investigations or reports relating to a new City Police Station and/ or new ACT Policing Headquarters. As no such work has been undertaken on behalf of iCBR, there are no associated costs, scopes, findings, outcomes, or reports to provide.

As outlined in the 2026/27 ACT Budget, iCBR will continue the market and procurement process for a new ACT Police Headquarters and City Police Station.
