Objection to Draft Variation to the Territory Plan No. 299 – Lawson South

I hereby lodge objection to Recommended Variations to the Territory Plan Number 299 Lawson south.

My objection is for the same reasons given by the Chief Minister and others as to why several hundred kangaroos had to be destroyed in the adjoining Commonwealth land known as Lawson north - The protection of rare native grasses and various rare species of insects.

Given that both areas of land are only separated by chain wire fencing, there can be no guarantee that the same rare native grasses and various rare species of insects are not present in the area referred to as Lawson south.
