Our home was tested in 13 places for asbestos and none was found.

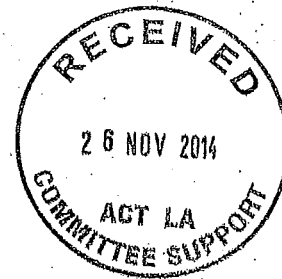
It is a double brick house and they say there could be asbestos in the cavity.
