Corrigendum to the ACT Standing Committee on Public Accounts Report No. 23— Review of Auditor-General's report No. 7 of 2015: *Sale of ACTTAB*

At paragraph no. 3.4, page 9:

The direct quote—sourced from the final transcript for 2 November 2015—and attributed to an official from the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate at paragraph 3.4, page 9, was incorrect.

An amended paragraph 3.4 is provided below.

3.4 As part of its inquiry into 2014–15 annual reports, the Committee sought confirmation that ACN 071257504 had been deregistered on 19 July 2015 as reported. An official advised:

Yes it was deregistered...in early July, I think. It actually lapsed into this financial year because we had to clean up some issues that were discussed at the budget hearings, but that has all been done. In terms of the residual part of the business at the moment where effectively it has been wound down, there is a small amount of money left, about \$40,000 of costs, which the territory will bear in the final wrap-up, which is related to the residual ICT systems and the statutory liability obligations around insurance for the ex-board.¹
