QON 25* Asked by MR COE:

In relation to: enterprise agreements

1. Have the parameters of the next round of ACT public sector enterprise agreement bargaining been settled?
2. What is the timeframe for the next round of ACT public sector enterprise agreement bargaining?

CHIEF MINISTER: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

1. No, the parameters for the next round of ACT public sector enterprise agreement bargaining have not yet been settled.
2. The current round of ACT public sector enterprise agreement bargaining commenced in November 2016 and meetings with bargaining representatives have continued since that time. The current enterprise agreements have a nominal expiry date of 30 June 2017 (with the exception of the Education Directorate Teachers' Agreement which expires 30 September 2018) and will continue in force after the nominal expiry date until replaced. Bargaining will be concluded as soon as possible.
