RE: INQUIRY INTO BILLBOARDS


Limits on and strict regulations for advertising have enabled Canberra to develop and maintain a unique character and aesthetic beauty derived from the balance between the built and natural environments. Canberra's unique character as a bush capital attracts both visitors and new residents, and would be harmed if visual pollution were allowed to proliferate. The National Capital should be protected from such visual pollution.
