2. How have these progressed?
3. When does the Minister expect an outcome by?
4. How much is the ACT government willing to pay for the reclamation of the lake?

ANDREW BARR: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

1. Yes.
2. Through meetings and correspondence between Governments.
3. These negotiations are progressing well, but it is too early to estimate a timeframe for their resolution.
4. It would be inappropriate to answer this question while negotiations with the Commonwealth are under way.
