THE CHAIR: On that, minister, or Mr Marshall, would you be able to take on notice, if it is not too much trouble, how many complaints we have received from the public in the 2018-19 year compared to the 2017-18 year about streetlights being out. Certainly, in my office, it has gone from being probably number one or two issue to not an issue. But very interested to see what those stats are.

Mr Marshall: Yes. So what we would be able to provide is the number of requests for service that we have received. So I guess, the number that become a complaint is a little more complex, but that request for service.

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

The number of streetlight requests for service includes:

For the year 2018-19: 6,938 requests.

For the year 2017-18: 8,001 requests.
