5. What was the government's response to those recommendations?

Gordon Ramsay MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

The Whole of Government Working Group on the Arts has not been established. artsACT uses existing governance and policy mechanisms within the ACT Government that enable Whole of Government consultation and input on cross portfolio arts issues. This approach has been considered preferable to creating a separate forum outside of existing consultative mechanisms.
