Asked by Ms Jo Clay MLA: To ask the Minister for Police and Emergency Services:

In relation to: Budgets for future bushfire seasons

JCSAR p263

Significant costs were incurred managing the 19-20 bushfire season of \$20.6 million. What work is being done to ensure that in future years we have the budget and resources to respond?

Mick Gentleman MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

The Government has invested, and will continue to invest, in ensuring that our community continue to live in one of the safest cities in the world, with well-funded, well-resourced, and well-governed emergency services.

For urgent and unforeseeable events that are outside the scope of agency budgets, such as the 2019-20 bushfires, the existing Treasurer's Advance mechanism under section 18 of the Financial Management Act 1996 provides for the management of these costs.
