Asked by Mrs Elizabeth Kikkert:

In relation to:

**THE CHAIR:** Okay. And currently, there is one transport unit that is not being used, is that correct, the Romeo 3?

**Mr Johnson:** No, as I understand they are all—we are using them, they are all being used in surface.

**THE CHAIR:** Oh okay. Because when we did the tour for the Romeo 5, I was told that one of the vehicles is not being used because it needs to be replaced.

**Mr Johnson:** I would have to take one on notice to double check, it might have been out of service for servicing or for damage or something.

Mr Mick Gentleman MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

Out of the five Court Transport Unit (CTU) vehicles, one is currently non-operational due to mechanical issues (R4) and one secure vehicle is being utilised by the Alexander Maconochie Centre fleet. To ensure CTU has enough available vehicles, ACT Corrective Services has acquired a loan vehicle from Corrective Services NSW.
