Asked by Elizabeth Kikkert MLA: To ask the Minister for the Prevention of Domestic and Family Violence

Ref: Safer Families, Budget Outlook p 377

In relation to: male victims of domestic violence

1. For each year the past 5 years, how many men have contacted the following service providers for support as victims of domestic violence:
  - a. Domestic Violence Crisis Support (DVCS)
  - b. OneLink
2. For each year the past 3 years, how many men have been provided crisis accommodation by DVCS?
3. For each year the past 3 years, how many men contacted DVCS for support, but were unable to be supported by DVCS due to conflict of interest in already supporting their counterpart?
  - a. In such cases, what service providers does DVCS refer them to receive support?
4. For each year the past 5 years, how many men have been provided crisis accommodation by OneLink?

YVETTE BERRY MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

1 – 4. The ACT Government does not hold this data and there is insufficient time to consult with DVCS or OneLink to provide this data before the Standing Committee Report on Estimates is due. Relevant information was provided recently in response to Questions Taken on Notice 21/54, 21/55, and 21/56.
