Mr James Milligan MLA: To ask the Minister for Police and Emergency Services, Mr Mick Gentleman MLA

In relation to: accountability indicators (p. 25)

- 1. The Incident response rate for the Ambulance service was again below target, with a 12% variance, and only 50% of ambulances able to attend within the target time. The note (p. 26) states there is an overall increase in the demand for service. Is the inability to attend on time:
 - a. Is this due to a lack of appropriate locations for Ambulances in the ACT?
 - b. Is this due to a lack of Ambulances available in the ACT?
 - c. Is this due to a lack of appropriately qualified staff in the ACT?
 - d. When will further new ambulances and staff be added so that the targeted response times can be attained?
