- 4. What exactly are the deliverables?

Mick Gentleman MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

- 1. The \$236,000 was a milestone payment for the Mobile Duress System (MDS) on the completion of stage 2 works. The system installation was impacted by COVID restrictions in NSW and the ACT from early 2021. This has delayed the delivery of stage 2, and as a result has delayed the milestone payment, hence re-profiling from 2020-21 to 2021-22 was required.
- 2. This line item relates to the initiative to replace the existing staff MDS at the AMC. This initiative was approved by the ACT Government as a part of 2018-19 Budget.
- 3. This line item will be fully expended through the implementation of the new MDS.
