ANSWER TO QUESTION ON NOTICE

Asked by Ms Nicole Lawder MLA: To ask the Minister for Transport and City Services

Ref: Transport and City Services, Annual Report

In relation to: Mt Taylor

- 1. How much was spent on the recent improvements to the walking track at Mt Taylor from the Sulwood Drive carpark, including the zig zag track up Mt Taylor?
- 2. Why wasn't the stormwater ditch crossing, just 50m or so from the Sulwood Drive carpark gate, improved for wet weather periods?
- 3. Was this considered? How much would it cost to do?
- 4. What wet weather measures will be put in place to ensure access when this area floods?
- 5. What further improvements to the Mt Taylor Sulwood Drive carpark will be undertaken?
- 6. Have there been any reported accidents in the vicinity of the carpark in the 2020-21 year?

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

- 1. The total cost of the project was \$197,520.40.
- 2. The walking track upgrade did not consider work to the fire trail section as this work was done under the bushfire operations plan.
- 3. See 2.
- 4. The ACT Parks and Conservation Service is considering providing walking access by way of stepping stones or a small bridge to the side of the fire trail.
- 5. Further improvements are currently under design for the Mt Taylor Sulwood Drive carpark ingress and egress points.

6. From January 2020 to July 2021 there were 5 midblock crashes reported between Inkster Street and Livingston Avenue.
