Asked by JAMES MILLIGAN MLA on 24 FEBRUARY 2022: JOSEPHINE ANDERSEN took on notice the following question(s):

In relation to:

MR MILLIGAN: As I understand it, there is a **certificate II in construction** training offered to students who attend ACT schools and colleges.

...

I am not sure whether you will be able to answer this one: is this course only offered through CIT or is it also offered through independent RTOs?

Mr Steel: In terms of the school setting or are you talking more broadly?

MR MILLIGAN: In terms of the school setting, yes.

Mr Steel: I will hand over to Skills to provide some background on which RTO delivers that training in the skills setting.

Ms Andersen: We will have to take that on notice. It may be a course delivered by CIT. Until we find out which course it is, I am not able to answer that question.

## CHRIS STEEL MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

The Australian Government My Skills website (<a href="www.myskills.gov.au">www.myskills.gov.au</a>) identifies 58 registered training organisations (RTOs) offering the Certificate II in Construction (CPC20120), including four offering the course in the ACT.
