Inquiry into Auditor-General Report: 6/2021 – Teaching Quality in ACT Public Schools

The Standing Committee on Education and Community Inclusion announced on 5 October 2021 it would be undertaking an inquiry into the ACT Auditor-General's Report No. 6 of 2021 on Teaching Quality in ACT Public Schools. Submissions have closed and the Committee is currently conducting Inquiry hearings.

The ACT Branch Secretary of the Australian Education Union, Mr Patrick Judge, will be appearing as a witness at the second hearing for the Inquiry. It will be held at 1:30pm-2:30pm next Tuesday 29 March 2022 in the Prince Edward Island Room (Committee Room 1) at Legislative Assembly for the ACT, 196 London Circuit, Canberra.
