Asked by Mr Milligan on 23 August 2022: Minister Berry, Minister for the Prevention of Domestic and Family Violence took on notice the following question(s):

In relation to: Commonwealth funding

What Commonwealth funding has been provided for training of frontline services

Minister Berry: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: -

\$798,000 for domestic and family violence training and resources has been allocated from Commonwealth funds through the *National Partnership Agreement on Family, Domestic and Sexual Violence 2021-23* (NPA). This will support domestic and family violence training and resources for frontline community sector workers to enhance their skills and capability in best practice responses to victim-survivors of domestic and family violence.

An additional \$2.075 million will be made available from the NPA through an open grant round accessible to community sector organisations. There are several priorities for this funding, including for sector sustainability and capability building. It is anticipated that community sector organisations may identify and apply for training through this grants process.
