- Answers to QToNs should be emailed (Scanned signed PDF) to the Committee Support office at LACommitteeEstimates@parliament.act.gov.au within 5 working days of the receipt of the Uncorrected Proof Transcript (UPT). Day 1 is the first working day after the UPT is received. Example: If the question is taken on notice on Monday, the UPT is received on Tuesday, the answer should be submitted by close of business the following Tuesday (even if the hearings for the portfolio stretch across several days).
