Mr Steel: I am happy to take that question on notice. Obviously, it is a matter for across a range of agencies that we will have to—

Chris Steel MLA, Special Minister of State: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: -

The ACT Government funded 12 FTE positions in the 2021-22 budget for a period of two years to support processing applications received under the *Freedom of Information ACT 2016* (FOI Act) across six directorates. The Community Services Directorate has internally funded a further five FOI positions until June 2023.

Ongoing resourcing requirements for processing requests under the FOI Act will continue to be monitored and considered as part of future budget processes.
