MR JAMES MILLIGAN MLA: To ask the Minister for Police and Emergency Services

In relation to: Upgrade ES accommodation

(1) On p. 73 of the Budget Outlook there is mention of an Emergency Service accommodation upgrade at \$9.8 million:

- (a) Is this money for this year or was this rolled over from last year?
- (b) What is this money for?
- (c) Where is this money accounted for in the list of capital works program starting on p. 313 of the Budget Outlook?

MICK GENTLEMAN MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

- (a) The \$9.8 million in funding that has been rolled over from FY21/22.
- (b) This is Capital and Expense appropriation to undertake works associated with the Well-prepared Emergency Services – Gungahlin Joint Emergency Services Centre project.
- (c) Page 321 under Justice and Community Safety Directorate, \$8.490 million is identified as current works in progress.
