ANSWER TO QUESTION TAKEN ON NOTICE DURING PUBLIC HEARINGS

Asked by MS CLAY on 31 July 2023: Minister STEEL (Skills) took on notice the following question(s):

In relation to:

What is the cost of CEO salaries for CIT (annual and expected total amounts)?

MS CLAY: Thank you, Chair. The Chair just asked what the cost of that double payment was. And you said the cost of the salary, can you just tell us what the cost is, for anybody watching who would like to know what that is?

Ms Lundy: I would take that on notice. I do not have—

MS CLAY: Okay.

Ms Lundy: —that complete figure. Would you like an annual cost of the salary?

MS CLAY: The total expected amount, however you express that. So if—like, if you do not know how long the arrangement will be in place, just give us whatever information you can easily give us of what that is likely to be?

Ms Lundy: Certainly.

MS CLAY: Thank you.

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: —

The remuneration of the interim CIT CEO is determined by the Remuneration Tribunal. In addition to the remuneration noted in Determination 5 of 2023 Full Time Statutory Office Holders Determination 5 of 2023 - Full-Time Statutory Office Holders, the Remuneration Tribunal has allowed for the one-off relocation allowance of \$55,000 to be used for travel expenses, which as of 03 August 2023, approximately \$49,000 has been paid.
