In relation to: Major Projects Canberra and IS Ratings

How many MPC Projects have As Built Infrastructure Sustainability (IS) ratings from the Infrastructure Sustainability Council (ISC)?

Which projects are these?

Mr Andrew Barr MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

Major Projects Canberra's (MPC) is directly responsible for the delivery of designated projects.

In this context, the Light Rail Stage 1 Project achieved an As Built Infrastructure Sustainability (IS) rating of 'Leading'.

The CIT Woden Campus Project and the Canberra Hospital Expansion Project each seek Green Star ratings in achieving their environmental sustainability objectives.

MPC also supports Partner Directorates in the delivery of projects. Civil infrastructure projects with a budget of \$10 million or greater take into consideration an IS rating. The following examples of civil projects that are currently in delivery and aiming for As Built IS rating include:

- ACT Healthy Waterways – EPSDD Partner Directorate
- Monaro Highway Upgrade Program - TCCS Partner Directorate
- John Gorton Drive Bridge – TCCS Partner Directorate
