Can we also get people that were involved in the trip to Germany where they received this confidential information, they are not the people that were involved in the procurement process. Is there. Is there an overlap for some people and other people that were not in both of those reflective groups?

Mr Gentleman: There would be an overlap because I suppose that group actually look at procurement for ESA. So, we can certainly have a look at that.

MR PETERSSON: Yes. I get that there would be some people that would be involved in both groups but I am not sure if that would be everyone that would be involved in both groups.

Mick Gentleman MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

There was no overlap of any ESA staff/officials on the Evaluation Team for the Hybrid Electric Fire Truck and either of the two trips to Germany in May 2019 (pre-construction meetings for the ACTF&R aerial pumper and replacement aerial appliance) and September 2022 (Factory Acceptance Testing for the Hybrid Electric Fire Truck).
