In relation to: Critical Services Building Wi-Fi compatibility with Digital Health Record

**MS CASTLEY:** So I understand that the Wi-Fi that was installed in the new Critical Services Building was not compatible with DHR and the correct technology has to be retrofitted. Is that correct and—

**Minister Rachel Stephen-Smith MLA:** The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

The Wi-Fi system for the new Critical Services Building has been designed and installed in accordance with ACT Government ICT infrastructure requirements. These requirements include the ability of mobile handheld devices that may utilise the Digital Health Record (DHR) to connect to the Wi-Fi system.

Subject to ACT Government ICT security protocols, all mobile devices that have the ability to connect to Wi-Fi, will be able to connect.

There has been no retrofit of the Wi-Fi system.
