In relation to: Detainee Classification

Question Lodgement Date: 21/11/2023

- (1) At present, how many detainees have a maximum security classification?
  - (a) Of these, how many are remandees and how many are sentenced?
  - (b) Of these, how many are aged between 18-29?
  
- (2) At present, how many detainees have a medium security classification?
  - (a) Of these, how many are remandees and how many are sentenced?
  - (b) Of these, how many are aged between 18-29?
  
- (3) At present, how many detainees have a minimum security classification?
  - (a) Of these, how many are remandees and how many are sentenced?
  - (b) Of these, how many are aged between 18-29?


MICK GENTLEMAN: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

ACT Corrective Services (ACTCS) records indicate that as of 22 November 2023, there were 372 detainees in the Alexander Maconochie Centre (AMC). This includes:

- (1) 46 detainees with a Maximum Security classification.
  - a. Of these, 27 detainees were on remand and 19 detainees were sentenced, and
  - b. 22 (out of the 46) detainees were aged 18–29 (17 on remand and 5 sentenced).
  
- (2) 204 detainees with a Medium Security classification.
  - a. Of these, 99 detainees were on remand and 105 detainees were sentenced, and
  - b. 60 (out of the 204) detainees were aged 18–29 (31 on remand and 29 sentenced).

- (3) 122 detainees with a Minimum Security classification.
- a. Of these, 45 detainees were on remand and 77 detainees were sentenced, and
  - b. 18 (out of the 122) detainees were aged 18–29 (7 on remand and 11 sentenced).
