### **ANSWER TO QUESTION ON NOTICE**

Asked by Mrs Elizabeth Kikkert:

Reference: Hearing on 15 November 2023, Annual Report of Community Services Directorate

In relation to: Women's Health Matters victim survivor consultation model

(1) The ACT Government invested \$375,000 for Women's Health Matters to design and pilot a victim survivor consultation model. When is the design expected to be completed?

(2) What are the expected start and end dates of the pilot, and how many participants are funded by the pilot?

Minister Berry: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

(1) Design of the model is expected to be complete by April 2024.

(2) The victim-survivor consultation model is expected to be piloted between May 2024 and March 2025. The number of participants in the pilot will depend on the model design and willingness of victim-survivors to participate in the consultation.
