In relation to: ACT Domestic and Family Violence Death Review

(1) What kind of data system did the ACT Government procure in relation to the Domestic and Family Violence Death Review and what was the cost of the procurement?

Minister Berry: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

The ACT Domestic and Family Violence Review (DFVR) engaged Prometix to develop a tailored and secure case management system built on the Microsoft Dynamics 365 platform. The system enables qualitative and quantitative data storage of domestic and family violence incidents and integrates security measures to ensure the protection of sensitive information.

The cost of the procurement was \$197,120 (including GST). Details of this procurement can be found on the Tenders ACT website.
