In relation to: Monitoring of loose-fill asbestos properties

THE CHAIR: Monitor it. The Annual Report also notes WorkSafe completed over 120 monthly compliance inspections on their remaining list of Fluffy properties, which you were talking about, where residents still reside. How many residents are currently subject to this intensity of monitoring and what do the inspections involve?

Ms Grey: We would have to take on notice the number.


Ms Agius: The number.

THE CHAIR: Yes, sure.

Mick Gentleman MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

There are 15 properties affected by loose-fill asbestos (Mr Fluffy) which WorkSafe ACT monitors for compliance. The compliance check involves inspecting whether the property has an up-to-date Asbestos Management Plan displayed within close proximity to the front door.
