On page 364 of the ACT health directorate annual report book notes walk-in centre as a part of the ACT local hospital network.

- 1) How often has the Gungahlin walk-in centre been closed due to lack of staff?
- 2) How often is the Gungahlin walk-in centre visited?

MINISTER STEPHEN-SMITH: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

- 1) The Gungahlin Walk-in Centre has not closed due to lack of staffing or being unable to provide clinical care and service to the ACT community.
- 2) From July 2022 to June 2023 there have been 20,106 presentations to the Gungahlin Walk-in Centre. A breakdown of the presentations by month is below.
