1. What is the status of the Multimodal Network Plan? (p. 110)
2. What is the current status of the Gungahlin Transport Plan? (p. 23)

Ms Tara Cheyne MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

1. TCCS engaged SMEC to develop a Multimodal Network Plan technical report. This report, which was completed in August 2024, provides guidance on the future function and modal priorities for arterial roads and other key areas of the transport network. It also provides recommendations to guide future investment on infrastructure and services initiatives – to achieve the vision and objectives of the ACT Transport Strategy.
2. TCCS engaged WSP Australia to assist with developing the Gungahlin Transport Plan. WSP Australia delivered its final report in January 2025. The focus of this report is the Gungahlin Town Centre. A separate project deliverable was to develop a Technical Memo to identify priority transport corridor segments for infrastructure improvements. The final report and technical memo will now be used to develop the ACT Government's transport plan for Gungahlin.
