Details:

The child was displaying a large outburst of emotions in the Preschool room and another educator (P01) was phoned to assist. When the other educator arrived, the child was throwing toys over the fence and at educators, spitting at educators and using a shovel to hit the Preschool educator. The child also attempted to climb the fence during this time. An educator attempted to redirect the child by offering to help feed the chickens, the child agreed and collected scraps to feed the chickens. As the educator was closing the door to the chicken coop, the child ran straight to the fenceline and began climbing the fence. The educator immediately followed however was unable to stop the child climbing over the fence. The child ran across the driveway onto the grass area (centre evacuation point) where the educator was able to stop him from continuing further. The educator held the child's hand and came back into the Preschool room. The child continued to throw resources at staff and spit at them. The decision was made to bring the child to the office with P01 where the behaviour continued. P01 phoned the Area Manager to seek support to call the child Mother and collect the child. When the Mother arrived, P01 explained the support offered for the child and herself. The Mother did not seem surprised by the state of the office.

Immediate Actions:

- 1) Educators attempted to redirect P01 by feeding the chickens (which he agreed), along with numerous sensory experiences.
- 2) Educators ran to stop P01 from getting any further and removed the child from the environment as a safety concern was raised for children and team.

Actions to be Taken:

- 1) When time is spent in the preschool yard, 2 educators (minimum) will be present and actively supervising the children at all times.
- 2) Conversing with P01 (mother) and support team to discuss strategies to help P01 when he is displaying such large emotions in a destructive way. I.e. quite sensory corner (playdough, water balls etc.)
- 3) Inviting P01 (mother) and her support team (social worker, occupational therapist, P01's speech therapist etc.) in service to discuss further strategies.
