THE CHAIR: Okay. Is the government able to provide the costings that they have spent on property maintenance and upgrades, since 2017 to today, on property for an approved SDA participant, if they were able to access that? Can you also provide how much you have spent on maintenance and upgrades for someone that could have potentially been qualified to receive commonwealth funding for those upgrades?

Ms Yates: I have the amount that we spent on repairs and maintenance in the properties that were enrolled from the period of 2020 to 2025. But we cannot link that to whether or not they were NDIS participants who may or may not have been eligible for SDA. But I can provide the figure for the repairs and maintenance that were undertaken in that period.
