**Ms Wark:** Yes, we do have a small fleet of EV vehicles that were available for that training.

**MR EMERSON:** I am particularly interested in the interstate trainings where perhaps those simulation—

**MR EMERSON:** —where those were not available, what vehicles were used when you were in Melbourne, Dubbo, Wodonga, Sydney, Narooma?

**Mr Nichols:** I think we just take that on notice, Mr Emerson. We will come back to you with some clarifications around that.

Mr Rogers: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

Vehicles used for interstate EV training between July 2025, and March 2026 comprised a mixture of industry client supplied vehicles, simulators, an EV Centre of Excellence vehicle, and hire vehicle(s).

As the use of EV vehicles for training is under investigation, no further details are able to be provided at this time.
