Dear Ms Jaireth

I know this is a while after the event, but I assume the issue is ongoing. (I also admit I am not always prompt in answering E-mails).

In my submission, Climate change abatement policy should include the following components, by way of minimum terms:

- . 25% reduction of greenhouse gas emission rates by 2020 - or consistent with scientific recommendations;
- . a policy structure which takes account of the cumulative effect of household measures to mitigate emissions - e.g. the use of solar energy in houses, energy conservation measures like insulation, simple reduction in energy use from fossil sources etc. (I have a Solar Hart hot water system - I would hate to think it would have the negative effect of giving more permit to big polluters).;

- . policies which positively encourage a transition from a fossil fuel base for energy generation to a renewable one.

I pray this submission be considered in the spirit of an ongoing wave of policy development in the matter.
