b. CALWELL PARK AND RIDE-first raised as an issue by community 2010,
approved by the Assembly Oct 2011 for installation Mar12 – no construction to date

c. MOBILE LIBRARY-in Mar2010 we wrote to the Mobile Library Service
seeking to expand the service to include Theodore, Calwell etc and advised that a
detailed needs assessment would need to occur.

A. URBAN INFILL We note \$430K allocated to investigate future Urban Infill
opportunities in this budget. However, Chisholm Community Park(CCP)

continues to suffer attacks over the use of these blocks at great expense to the government when there are any number of blocks that could be used that the public would not object to using. (CCP). The community want this park in its present size and location retained for all time.

- B. **CALWELL PARK AND RIDE.** We note the government policy 2011-12 to build other park and ride facilities, which should include the Calwell facility. We were originally told work was to commence Mar2012, but the RTA have told our community meeting last Sunday 10 Jun12 that they have not yet gone to open tender. The community felt that it might not happen at all. We would like assurances that it will go ahead and without delay.
- C. **MOBILE LIBRARY EXPANSION TO SERVICE.** We are unsure what funds are available this financial year, but would like to see a needs assessment/expansion of the service of Theodore/Calwell to occur this financial year.
