Mr Phillips: Mr Coe, Brett Phillips, Executive Director, Office of Regulatory Services. The percentage of up time across the system is 85 per cent.

MR COE: 85 per cent of functioning cameras.


Mr Phillips: Functioning cameras.

MR COE: And what about—so there—it has got to be considerably less than that if you actually take into account the cameras that are not functioning?

Mr Corbell: I think we have to take that question on notice, Mr Coe, and provide that figure to you.

Mr Simon Corbell MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

Uptime for the fixed traffic camera network for the period 1 July 2013 to 31 May 2014 was 85%. This includes fixed cameras that weren't operational.
