**Mr Lane:** Thanks, minister. Chair, Dominic Lane, ESA commissioner. Just further to the minister's answer there, the review is well and truly underway. A plan of consultation is out with staff and so the review takes a number of elements: firstly, in relation to a doctrinal review of literature in relation to ambulance culture nationally and internationally. The second part, which is very close to commencing, relates to a number of visits to ambulance stations and what we call ride-alongs, where the reviewers themselves will be able to meet with ambulance staff in the field and take their way through the work that they do as well as a number of other meetings and the like. In addition to that, a process is being put in place of communications with myself, the Chief Officer of ACTAS and the Transport Workers Union to keep staff updated on the progress of the review.

**THE CHAIR:** All right. What is the cost of the review?

**Mr Lane:** I would have to take that one on notice, Mr Chair.

Mr Simon Corbell MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

The cost of the review of organisational culture in the ACT Ambulance Service by O2C is anticipated to be \$25,000 (exclusive of GST).
