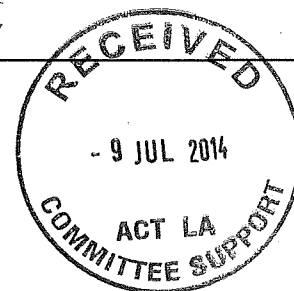

Asked by Mr Smyth on 27 June 2014: Mr Dawes took on notice the following question(s):

In relation to: subscription rate for a new block

THE CHAIR: Given the changes that have been announced to the traffic arrangements that were originally proposed, will a new traffic study be done?

Mr Barr: Yes.

Mr Dawes: We are currently undertaking a renewed traffic study as we speak; it is currently being done.

THE CHAIR: What is the status of the SMEC study that was done?

Mr Dawes: It is being updated. I believe it is a few weeks away. I would have to take that on notice to be exact. We embarked on a review and refresh of some of the work that we have undertaken previously.

MINISTER BARR: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

As a result of traffic and transport concerns raised by the community during the current engagement process, the LDA has re-engaged SMEC to update the traffic modelling outcomes and review the traffic report. This work is being supported by the Environment and Sustainable Development Directorate, Territory and Municipal Services and the Economic Development Directorate. A revised traffic study by SMEC will be made available to the public in August/September 2014.
