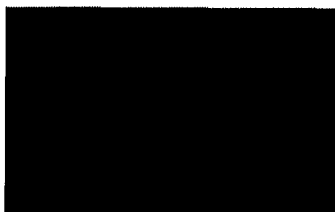
RE: INQUIRY INTO BILLBOARDS

Limits on and strict regulations for advertising have enabled Canberra to develop and maintain a unique character and aesthetic beauty derived from the balance between the built and natural environments. Canberra's unique character as a bush capital attracts both visitors and new residents, and would be harmed if visual pollution were allowed to proliferate.

We support the current rules and practices concerning billboards in the ACT, and believe that they should be applied to any other similar types of signage. Limits on the placement and construction of billboard advertising are, in my view, appropriate and meet the Canberra community's needs. We would oppose the establishment of designated areas for billboard advertising or any other relaxation of the current regulations.
