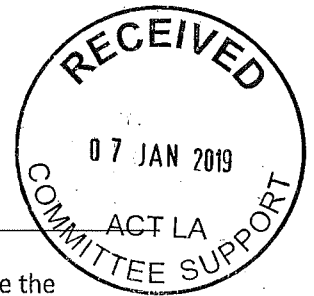

Answer to Question Taken on Notice in hearings

Asked by Ms Nicole Lawder MLA on 12 December 2018: Mr Ben Ponton took on notice the following question(s):

In relation to:

MS LAWDER: So how do you get a feel for what percentage of emails are added to electronic records? Is there some record keeping that, you know, says, "Oh, there has been a million emails sent and 4,000 of them have, you know, been added to a file," or—

Mr Ponton: I do not have that information. I could certainly give you information as to how many records are saved in Objective.

MS LAWDER: But in terms of your governance, you know—saying that you—encouraging people. Do they have any data to go on?

Mr Ponton: I am sure that we could provide you with the number of records in a particular period of time that have been saved into Objective, but it will be many hundreds of thousands.'

Mr Ponton: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

Since establishment of the land portfolio in July 2017, there has been on average, approximately 24,800 emails alone saved into the Objective electronic document record management system, each month.
