Transport Canberra and City Services Directorate, 2018–19 Annual Report, output class 2.4 City Maintenance and Services

In relation to graffiti and other vandalism

1. How much did the ACT Government spend in 2018–19 removing graffiti across the territory, and how much was spent specifically removing graffiti within the Ginninderra Electorate?
2. How much did the ACT Government spend in 2018–19 repairing other (non-graffiti) vandalism across the territory, and how much was spent specifically repairing vandalism in the Ginninderra Electorate?

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

1. TCCS expended \$812,158.97 on graffiti management across the Territory. A regional breakdown is not available.
2. TCCS expended \$100,528.22 on vandalism across the Territory. A regional breakdown is not available.
