Asked by Mrs Elizabeth Kikkert MLA: To ask the Minister for Corrections

In relation to: Recommendation 68 and inspection of mail

Ref: JACS Annual Report 2019-2020, Output 2.1, "ACT Inspector of Correctional Services – Healthy Prison Review of the AMC 2019"

- 1. Has the ACT Government fully implemented recommendation 68?
- 2. Is the hardcopy mail of detainees sent to legal representatives unmonitored by ACTCS?
- 3. How does ACTCS differentiate between mail sent to legal representatives and mail sent to non-legal representatives without opening and inspecting the mail?

Mick Gentleman MLA: I am advised that the answer to the Member's question are as follows:-

- 1. Yes. Recommendation 68 was fully implemented in September 2019.
- 2. Mail that is clearly marked as 'legal mail' between detainees and legal representatives is unopened by ACTCS staff.
- 3. Mail that is being sent to legal representatives should be clearly marked as legal mail to allow staff to differentiate it from mail being sent to other parties.
