FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST- DECISION NOT MADE IN TIME

I refer to an access application received by the Transport Canberra and City Services Directorate on 28 January 2021 made under the Freedom of Information Act 2016.

The applicant is seeking access to most up-to-date "Community Path Priority List".

A decision was due on this application by 25 February 2021.

I am writing to inform you that a decision on the application was not made in the time allowed under section 40. The directorate had requested an extension from the applicant prior to the end of 20 working days, however a response was not received until two days after the due date. The applicant did not agree to the extension request.

The Directorate has advised the applicant of the deemed refusal process.

In accordance with section 39(3), the Directorate continued to deal with the application and a decision was made on 2 March 2021. The notice of decision has been provided to the applicant.
