In relation to:

Why has the sportsgrounds maintenance budget decreased by almost \$7 million?

Ms Yvette Berry MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

The Sportsgrounds recurrent budget for the 2021-22 financial year is materially consistent with the recurrent budget for the 2020-21 financial year.

The reduction in cost of \$6.7m between the interim outcome 2020-21 and the 2021-22 budget relates to Output 2.4, City Maintenance and Services, on page 19 of 2021-22 ACT Budget Statement H for Transport Canberra and City Services, refer extract below. Output 2.4 includes Sportsgrounds.

The interim outcome for Output 2.4 in the 2020-21 year includes higher costs associated with the COVID-19 pandemic which are not reflected in the 2021-22 budget.
